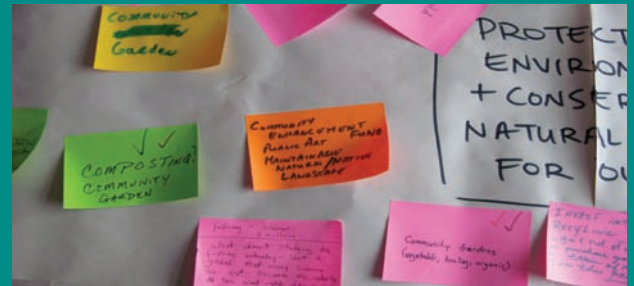

2010 Olympic Legacies

As part of our participation as one of four Host Nations for the Olympic Games, we recently signed onto a Shared Legacies Agreement that will create a special Legacy Trust Fund established by Musqueam for the benefit of present and future members. Under the Agreement, this Trust cannot be used for normal operations or for distribution to members.

The Legacy Trust Fund can be used to support five different types of activities:

- >> **Acquisition of land for Musqueam**
- >> **Capacity building**
- >> **Enhancement of skills and training**
- >> **Preservation and strengthening of Musqueam culture and ceremonies**
- >> **Economic opportunities for Musqueam**

Sports Facility Planning



In March, 2009 Council carried a motion to accept a recommendation to locate a sports facility on the 5-acre site. The proposed facility would include a grass soccer field, a two-storey field house, a maintenance shed and parking. Sports field planning began back in 2008 when it was identified as a 'quick start' opportunity in the Comprehensive Community Planning process. Community support for the project is high - 90% support was reported in community survey. The Community recognized that this facility would be central to the health and well-being of the membership, and an integral part of the long term land use plan.

Musqueam Planning Process - The image below shows the work conducted to date as part of Musqueam's on-going planning work. Upcoming planning events include Musqueam Days, an information fair in September and family gatherings later in the fall to help complete the *We Speak with One Heart and Mind* community planning effort.



Multi-Family and Phase 3 Development - Community engagement to look at Phase 3 of the Physical Development Plan has confirmed that this development is supported by members. The proposed plans include multi-family housing and a facility with offices and a gym. Specific programming for the building still needs additional work and will depend on other proposed plans identified in the Comprehensive Community Plan - *We Speak with one Heart and Mind*. For now, we are working on securing additional funding for the project.
