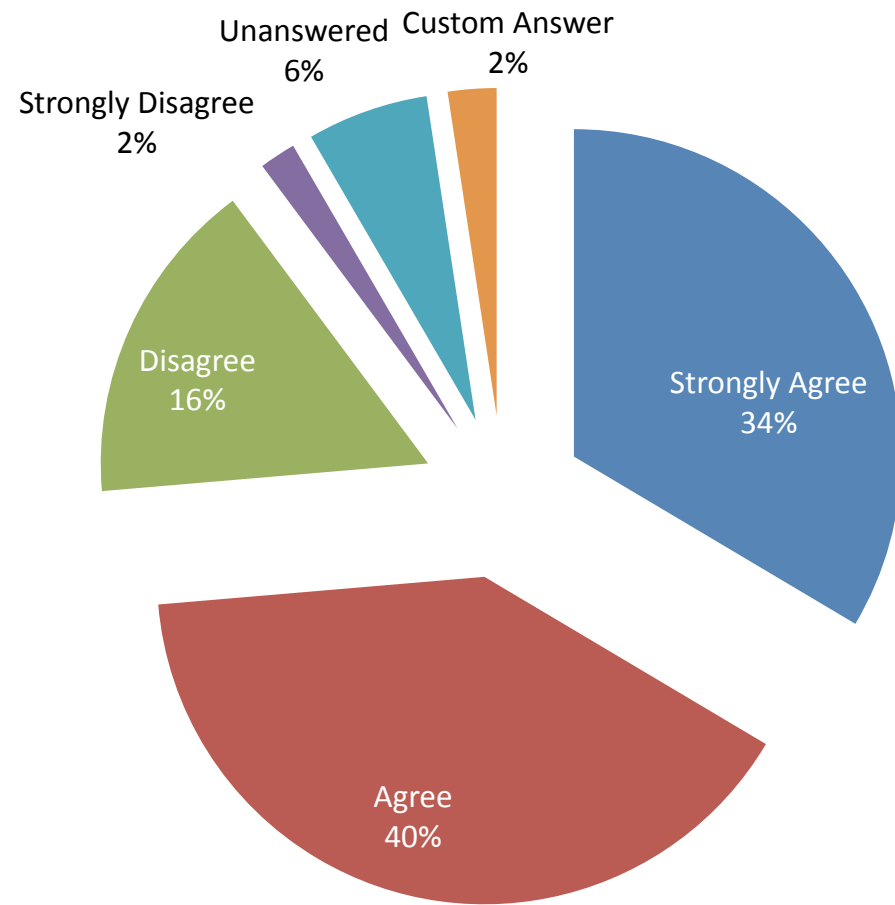

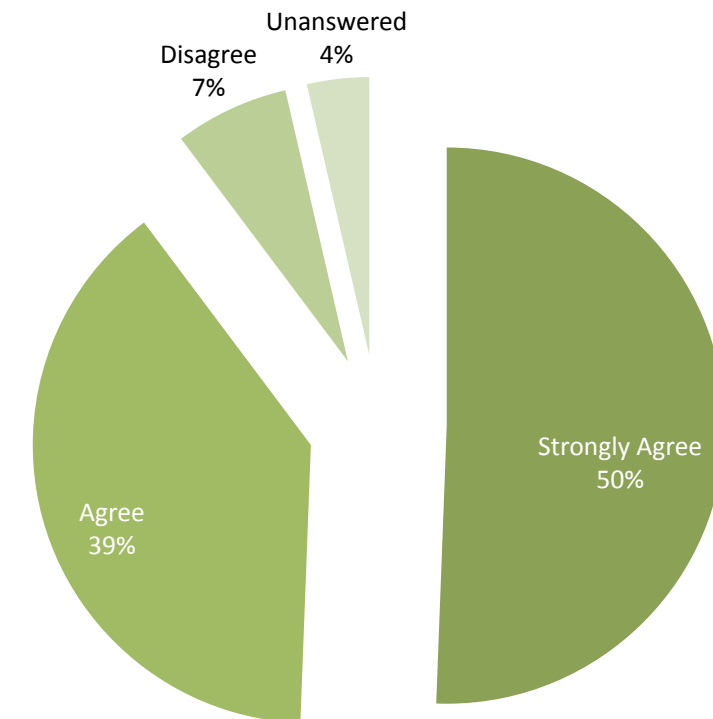


MUSQUEAM COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY PLAN COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

WE SHOULD HAVE A STRONGER VISIBLE PRESENCE THROUGHOUT OUR TRADITIONAL TERRITORY?

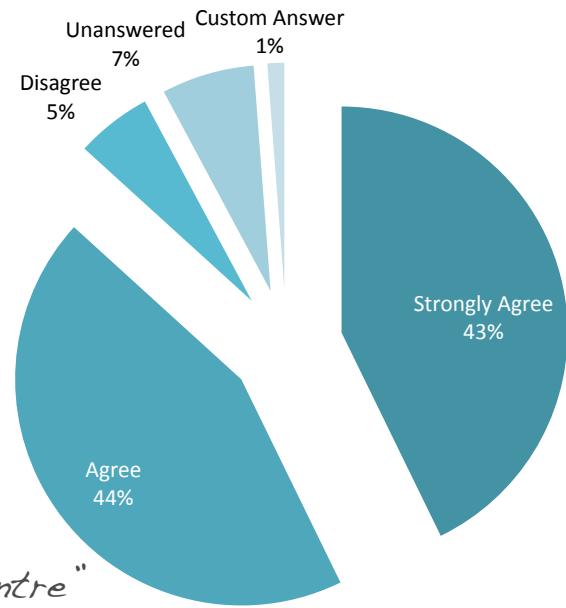

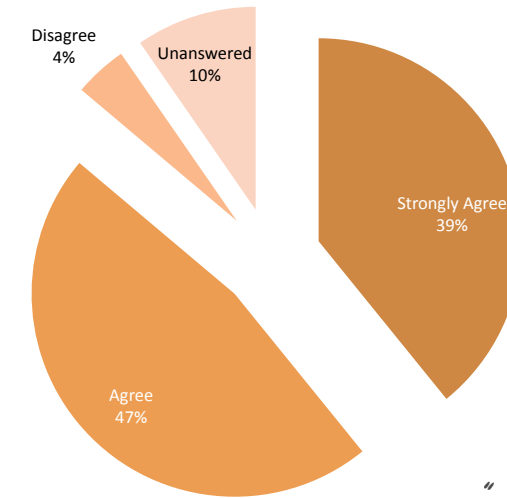

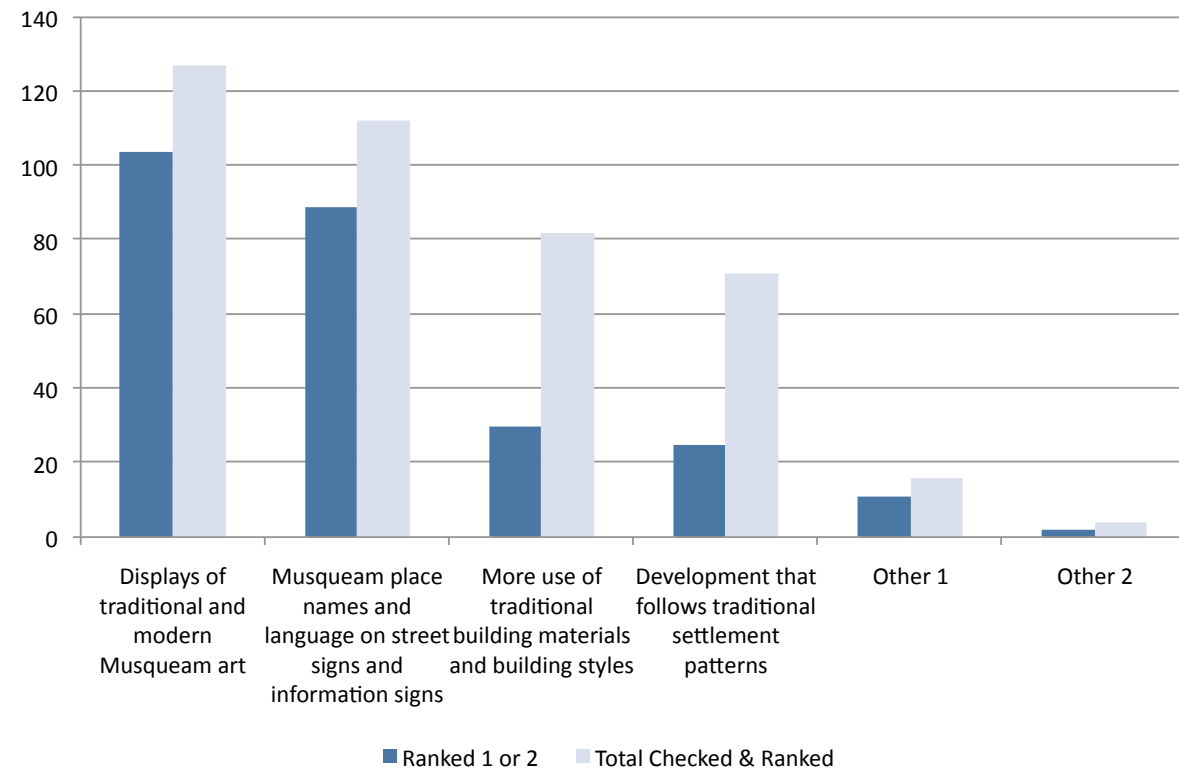
